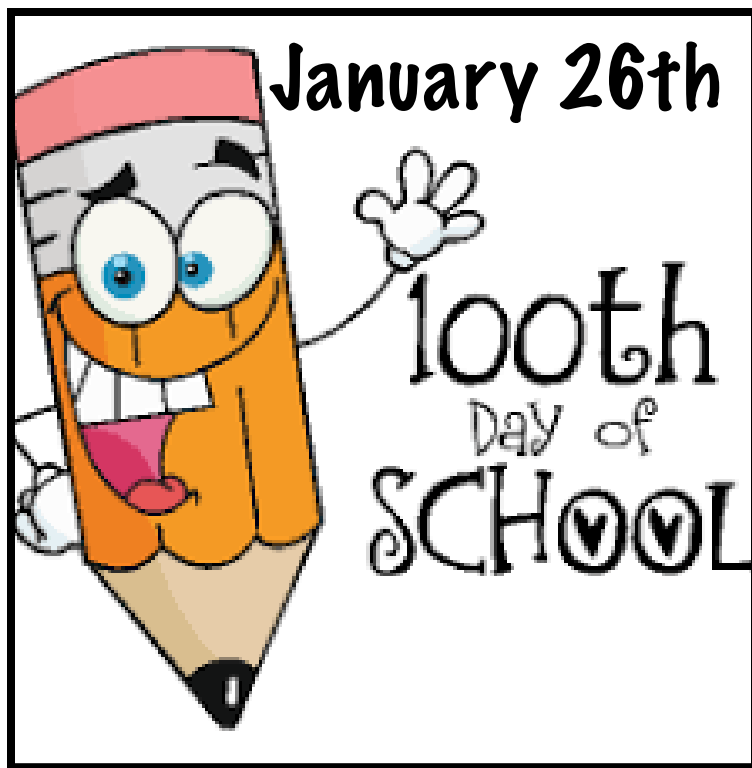

Yutan Youth Soccer Club

What: Registration for the 2022 Yutan Youth Soccer Club (playing through Wahoo Recreation Department) is now open.

Registration will only be available online through the Yutan Youth Sports website: www.yutan-youthsports.com - Soccer - "2022 Yutan Youth Soccer Registration"

*Registration is also open for participants to register for the Yutan Youth Soccer Clinic.

The clinic will take place at the Yutan Activities Center on Saturday, February 26 from 10AM-2PM. More specific information about that day will be sent out after registration has occurred. Cost for the clinic is \$15. (The participants will have a little over 1 hour dedicated to their age group)

*You must fill out two separate registrations for the soccer season and the soccer clinic to participate in both. You will only have to pay what you register for.

When: Registration is open through Friday, February 11, 2022

League Format:

Pre-K & Kindergarten Instructional League: Participants must be 4 years old by March 1st, 2022. Games are played 6 vs. 6 with approximately 8-9 players on a team. A size 3 ball is used. No goalie is used and no game scores or league standings are kept. The fundamentals of the game such as dribbling, passing, throw-ins, and teamwork will be emphasized. Volunteer parent coaches will lead a 20-30 minute practice followed by an informal scrimmage.

1st and 2nd Grade Micro Soccer: Games are played 6 vs. 6 with approximately 8-9 players on a team. A size 4 ball is used. No goalie is used and no game scores or league standings are kept. The fundamentals of the game such as dribbling, passing, throw-ins, and teamwork will be emphasized.

3rd through 5th Grade Soccer: Games are played 7 vs. 7 with approximately 10-11 players on a team. A size 5 ball is used. Goalies will be used. The level of play is more aggressive while focusing on fundamentals.

Cost: \$45 without a shirt/\$50 with a shirt. An additional \$10 will be charged for registrations received after Friday, February 11.

* Please communicate to the soccer board if the cost of the program prohibits your child from participating.

Practice location: Timbercrest Park—specific times and dates will be determined later in the spring.

Game Location: Hackberry Park in Wahoo

Yutan Youth Soccer Club is a 100% volunteer organization. It cannot function without the help and assistance of parent volunteers. Yutan Soccer Club will be looking for coaches at each age level for the Spring 2022 season. Do not worry if you have no experience with soccer as detailed practice plans and drills will be provided.
